Contract Title: Procurement of software licenses for MCloud hybridization

1. The *Republic of Moldova* has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the *Modernization of Government Services Project*, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract ref no.: **MD-EGA-70985-GO-RFB “Procurement of software licenses for MCloud hybridization”** with following lots: **Lot 1 –Microsoft Azure public cloud subscription; Lot 2 – VMware licenses for MCloud Platform and Lot 3 – Fudo Privilege Access Management.**
2. The *P.I. e-Governance Agency* now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for *software licenses for MCloud hybridization* in 3 (three) lots as follows:
Lot 1 –Microsoft Azure public cloud subscription;
Lot 2 – VMware licenses for MCloud Platform;
Lot 3 – Fudo Privilege Access Management.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011, revised July 2014* (“Procurement Guidelines”), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.
4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from *P.I. e-Governance Agency, Attention: Mr. Ion BARBĂRASĂ, Procurement Specialist, e-mail: procurements@egov.md* and inspect the bidding documents during office hours 0900 to 1700.
5. Bidders shall register for the bidding by written application at the e-mail addresses indicated below. A complete set of bidding documents in *English* will be sent via email after registration. Prior registration is required for submitting clarification questions on the bidding documents and receiving automatic notice of answers and of addenda to the bidding documents. The original version of the bidding documents, and any addenda to it, will be the binding one.
6. Electronic bidding will be permitted *only*. Bids must be submitted *electronically* to the e-mail address procurements@egov.md on or before 4 June 2020. *The electronic bidding submission procedures are described in the ITB 22.1of Bidding Documents*. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend the *online bidding opening procedure* as per ITB 22.1of Bidding Documents on **11:00 a.m., 4 June, 2020**.

7. All bids must be accompanied by a *Bid-Securing Declaration*.
